#### **RESIDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

The maximum fence height in a residential use district shall not exceed 6 feet. The maximum fence height in all other zoning districts shall not exceed 8 feet. All height dimensions shall be measured from the established grade to the topmost section of the fence. A gate or opening shall be provided in all fence enclosures. Any suitable construction material may be used for a fence except: chicken wire, square welded mesh wire, barbed wire, electrically charged wire, temporary snow fence, or solid cinder block, or to be topped with sharp-edged material except that this shall not be construed to prohibit picket fence. No fence shall be erected so as to extend forward of the side yard building line facing a street on a corner lot. The entire length of the fence shall be constructed of the same or harmonious material. No fences may be located within the front yard setback (as defined in the Hickory Hills Zoning Code) or on the public right-of-way. All fences shall be constructed so that the posts are located on the interior thereof in relation to the property on which the fence is being constructed. All fence posts shall be securely anchored in the ground to a depth of not less than 42 inches for wood & PVC fences and 36-42 inches for chain link fences.

Any fence which is constructed in a utility easement shall be constructed so that the posts may be removable or with gates to allow access to the easement.
